

Our Tuition Promise Fact Sheet

COLLEGE: Rosemont College, a private college in suburban Philadelphia

ANNOUNCEMENT: Announced a 43 percent reduction in tuition, beginning with the 2016-2017

school year

COSTS: Tuition dropping from \$32,620 to \$18,500 – a 43 percent reduction

Room and board dropping from \$13,400 to \$11,500 – a 14 percent

reduction

Total cost dropping from \$44,520 to \$30,000

WHY: To end the practice of publishing an artificially high "sticker price" for

which most students receive "discounts" in the form of grants and

scholarships, a practice that has become mainstream

To appeal to families who build college lists based on sticker price alone and who have overlooked Rosemont College, knowing its reputation for

academic excellence but believing it was too expensive

TIMING: The new tuition price will take effect next year, the 2016-2017 school year

AFFECTS: Tuition reduction will apply to all undergraduate students at Rosemont.

PERCENTAGE OF ROSEMONT STUDENTS WHO RECEIVE FINANCIAL AID:

99 percent
