Family Doctor – If you live nearby, a phone call to your physician will provide advice about caring for yourself or directing you to seek care elsewhere.



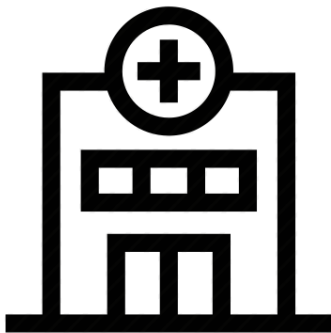
