1 year ahead

(2 semesters before your program begins):

• Visit the Office of Post Graduate Success to pick up study abroad packet and discuss possibilities

• Research programs and obtain info for the following year

• Discuss course choices with Academic Advisor and obtain course approvals

- Meet with financial aid (preliminary meeting to discuss financing options)
- Discuss program and finances with your parents
- Decide on program to which you will apply

After choosing your program:

- Start applying for scholarships
- Apply for your passport

1 semester ahead:


Note: many program deadlines are October 1, so you must complete these steps early in the fall semester for spring study abroad

• Complete forms in Rosemont's study abroad packet and finalize approvals

• Send application and any supplemental materials (i.e. transcript) to selected program by deadline date

- Continue to apply for scholarships by stated deadlines
- Meet with Financial Aid Office and submit Consortium Agreement to financial aid
